

Summer Camp Packing List

All personal equipment should be labelled with scout's name, hometown, and "Troop 15" or "T15".

Pack gear in large footlocker or tote. Scouts should arrive in Class A uniform and bring daypack and waterfront gear to check-in.

Not all items on this list are necessary. Use your best judgement.

Check-In

- ☐ Medication
(prescription medication must be in original container with scout name on label. Include only enough for camp)
- ☐ Missing med forms
- ☐ Missing adult leader forms
- ☐ \$13 for troop photo (optional)
- ☐ Money for Fri BBQ \$10/adult,\$6/youth (optional)

Clothing

Pack clothes based on weather forecast. Remember, while it can be hot during the day, it can still be very cool at night.

- ☐ Scout uniform (Class A including shorts, neckerchief and troop hat with correct patrol/position patches + optional scout socks, belt. OA members bring your sash.)
- ☐ Clothes hanger (for hanging uniform)
- ☐ Underwear (1 per day + extra)
- ☐ Socks (1 per day + extra)
- ☐ Rain gear (jacket/pants or poncho)
- ☐ Shorts (at least 3)
- ☐ T-shirts (including Class B, 1 per day or less)
- ☐ Long sleeve shirt (1)
- ☐ Pants (at least 1, rugged pair such as scout pants)
- ☐ Sweatshirt, vest, or jacket
- ☐ Pajamas (optional, loose sleeping clothes)
- ☐ Hiking shoes/boots
- ☐ Sneakers or comfortable walking shoes
(not crocs or flip-flops)
- ☐ Sunglasses (with lanyard)
- ☐ Hat with a brim for sun protection

Waterfront

- ☐ Swimsuit & water shirt
- ☐ Water shoes, crocs, or sandals
- ☐ Beach towel
- ☐ Goggles (optional)

Toiletries

Pack toiletries in leak-proof containers

- ☐ Toothbrush, toothpaste, & floss
- ☐ Soap & Shampoo/body wash
- ☐ Shower towel & wash cloth
- ☐ Deodorant (strongly recommended!)
- ☐ Brush/comb, mirror
- ☐ Talcum powder (baby powder, Gold Bond)
- ☐ Lip balm
- ☐ Shaving kit
- ☐ Other personal needs

Camp equipment

- ☐ Sleeping bag or blankets
- ☐ Sheet or mattress cover
- ☐ Pillow
- ☐ Mosquito net
- ☐ Ground cloth or tarp for tent platform.
- ☐ Camp chair
- ☐ Large trash bags and ziplocs
(for water-proofing gear if needed)
- ☐ Laundry bag (can be extra large trash bag)

Daypack

- ☐ Daypack (large enough to easily pack towel + gear)
- ☐ Water bottle
- ☐ Scout book
- ☐ Notebook & pen/pencil
- ☐ Headlamp and/or flashlight
- ☐ Extra batteries
- ☐ Personal first aid kit
- ☐ Compass & whistle
- ☐ 10 feet of paracord or small rope
- ☐ Pocketknife (need Totin' Chip to use)
- ☐ Sunscreen
- ☐ Insect repellent (non-aerosol preferred)

Optional equipment

- ☐ Spending money (sugg. \$5-8/day)
- ☐ Bicycle and Helmet
- ☐ Anything needed for merit badge work
- ☐ Partial merit badges
- ☐ Board/card/travel games
- ☐ Sports equipment (frisbees, balls, etc.)
- ☐ Mosquito headnet
- ☐ Bandanas/handkerchiefs
- ☐ Camera
- ☐ Clothesline and clothespins
- ☐ Fishing rod and tackle
- ☐ Travel mug (for hot drinks)
- ☐ Musical instrument
- ☐ Religious needs (Bible, prayer books)
- ☐ Reading material (old books are better)
- ☐ Sewing kit
- ☐ Phone and charger (leaders only)
- ☐ Lantern or light for tent (battery-powered only)
- ☐ Matches/firestarters
- ☐ Eyeglass case + lens cleaner
